Plastic bags are a huge source of ocean pollution, contribute to habitat loss, and can entrap and kill thousands of marine creatures each year. By using a reusable tote, you can reduce the amount of plastic bags used per year by 700. Did you know that pieces of plastic outnumber animals in the ocean at a ratio of 6:1? - 8 million pieces of litter end up in the ocean every day.

» DID YOU KNOW THAT THE AVERAGE AMERICAN USES 700 PLASTIC BAGS EVERY YEAR?

3 MONTHS = 175 BAGS 6 MONTHS = 350 BAGS 1 YEAR = 700 BAGS!

» IT TAKES 500 YEARS FOR A PLASTIC BAG TO DEGRADE » THE US RECYCLES ONLY 1-2% OF THE PLASTIC BAGS ANNUALLY.

» THE UNITED NATIONS ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME ESTIMATES THAT THERE ARE
46,000 PIECES OF PLASTIC LITTER FLOATING IN EVERY SQUARE MILE OF OCEAN.

» USING A REUSABLE TOTE CAN
HELP REDUCE THESE ISSUES.
